Assessment against this unit standard may take place under real or practical simulated conditions.

Special Notes:

Compliance with the providers Health and Safety policy and procedures in mandatory.

Assessing Element 1: Receive the BA equipment for testing and servicing.

Candidate ensures interpretation of user-reported problems allows remedial action to be taken in accordance with the requirements of the fire and rescue service provider.

Candidate ensures loan sets are issued in accordance with the requirements of the fire and rescue service provider.

Assessing Element 2: Test the BA equipment.

Candidate ensures tests are applied in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and instructions. This includes:

- full annual tests, or
- tests of specified faulty components

Candidate ensures tests are applied systematically and allow reported faults to be found in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and instructions.

Candidate ensures faults that are identified are actioned in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and instructions.

Assessing Element 3: Service the BA equipment.

Candidate ensures components are replaced, repaired and adjusted in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.

Candidate ensures faults are rectified in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.

Assessing Element 4: Carry out recording duties.

Candidate ensures documentation is completed in accordance with the requirements of the fire and rescue service provider.

Candidate ensures recording of costing details allows recovery action in accordance with the requirements of the fire and rescue service provider.
